

Plagiarism Guidelines

The Author must publish original, plagiarised free articles that have not been submitted to any other anywhere else while it is in the review stage. Multiple submission of the article to different sources at the same time is not acceptable. Multiple submission of the same article to the journal is not encouraged. In case the author is willing to retract the article at any stage of the review process, and before its publication, they can do the needful after due written information to the Co-editor of the journal.

The author must ensure that the article is free from plagiarism and AI writing. Only 10% of the plagiarised and AI material shall be allowed for due publication.

The author shall be solely responsible for the data and information included in the article. Therefore, the author should use verifiable sources and maintain intellectual, academic honesty at all times.

Articles disregarding the publication ethics shall be retracted and the author and co-authors involved shall be prohibited from making future submissions to the journal.

Plagiarism Screening

Submitted manuscripts may be checked using plagiarism detection software or through editorial evaluation. The Editorial Board reserves the right to reject manuscripts that show substantial similarity with previously published works.

Minor similarity arising from properly cited quotations, references, common terminology, or standard academic phrases may be acceptable at the discretion of the Editorial Board.

Action against Plagiarism

If plagiarism or academic misconduct is identified at any stage of the publication process, the journal may take appropriate action, including:

- Rejection of the manuscript
- Request for correction or revision
- Withdrawal or retraction of published articles

The responsibility for ensuring originality rests entirely with the author(s).

Ethical Responsibility of Authors

Authors are expected to maintain honesty, transparency, and ethical integrity in their research and writing. Proper acknowledgement of all intellectual contributions is mandatory.
