

## Publication Ethics

The corresponding author should provide the list of co-authors who have made substantial contribution to the article. A statement providing the details of the contribution of all the authors of the journal should be clearly stated in the cover letter at the time of submission.

Authors are to report any conflict of interest at the time of submission. Failure to declare shall lead to the withdrawal of the article from the publication site. Further, if the use of any unethical academic practices reported after publication shall automatically lead to the retracting of the article and the author and co-authors associated with the article shall be prohibited from future publication in the journal. If any errors are found in the article after submission, the author shall be given the opportunity for correction through proper mechanism, which includes the consultation with the Chief Editor and the editorial board. In such cases, the decision made by the editorial board shall be upheld.

Submission of a manuscript implies that the work is original and has not been submitted simultaneously to any other journal or publication outlet. The journal maintains a zero tolerance against plagiarism and AI writing.

The articles submitted to the journal should be free from racial, communal, religious, gender-based, or linguistic prejudice, and should uphold principles of academic fairness and inclusivity.
