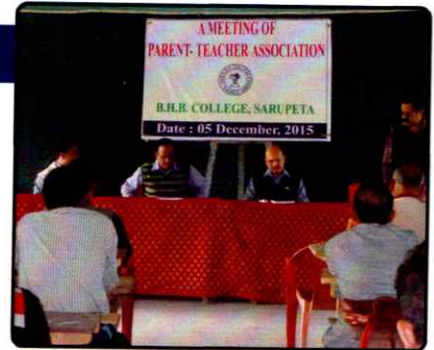


## Observance of Republic day
