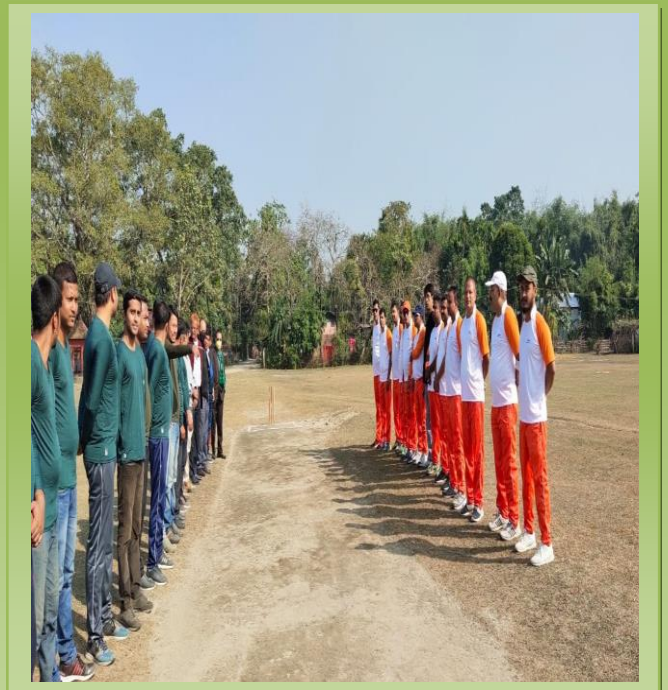
## PI Staff of 7 Assam Battalion Dhubri Trained the N.C.C. Cadets
