- B. Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program specific arrangements.

ARTICLE 5

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE

A. Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MoU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between both the Parties.

ARTICLE 6

AMENDMENT

- A. This MoU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of both the

ARTICLE 7

ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

A. This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signing.


