Memorandum of Understanding between

Established on the 1st of July 1971, Bhawanipur Hastinapur Bijni (BHB) College, an institution of higher learning at Sarupeta has been imparting higher education to learners belonging to an economically backward region that consists of three revenue mouzas, which are mentioned in the very name of the College. Located in Bajali district, BHB College is the oldest institution of this kind in 41-Bhawanipur Legislative Assembly Constituency, a segment of 5- Parliamentary Constituency of Assam, which is reserved seat for Scheduled Tribes.

And

National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), Guwahati has its main centre at AFC Building, Md. Shah Road, Paltanbazar, Guwahati-781008, Assam (hereinafter referred to as "NIELIT" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context of meaning, mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) of the second part. BHB College and NIELIT may hereinafter collectively be referred to as "Parties" and individually as "Party".

1. PURPOSE

To build a technical relationship between the institutes in re-skilling and empowering the students in areas of ICT (either in Digital Literacy or Industry oriented areas or Livelihood activities)

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2. COMMITMENTS

- i. **NIELIT Guwahati and BHB College** will conduct joint events like workshop, seminar, and training program.
- ii. **NIELIT Guwahati shall intimate BHB College** regarding the availability of training programs (e.g., Short Term, Long Term, Internship Training, Summer Training, Final year projects etc.).
- iii. **NIELIT Guwahati and BHB College** will share laboratories, and manpower whenever required.
- iv. **NIELIT Guwahati and BHB College** shall collaborate to facilitate the placement of successful candidates on completion of the training.
- v. **BHB College** will provide eligible students from time to time to NIELIT Guwahati whenever required.

3. DURATION, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT

- i. The validity of this MoU would be for a period of **two (2) years** with effect from the date of signing of this MoU. The MoU may be renewed on mutually agreed terms between the Parties.
- ii. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving six (6) months advance notice in writing to the other party.
- iii. The provisions of this MoU may be amended at any time with the mutual consent of the Parties in writing.
- iv. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination, and expiration unless otherwise agreed upon between the parties.

Three Days Workshop for Students, Women and Adult Person with National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology, Govt of India (NIELIT) on 23rd, 24th and 25th March, 2022 in B.H.B. College, Sarupeta.

Training Camp of Information Technology by NIELIT- Day 1: B.H.B. College, 23rd March, 2022 :

National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) Guwahati, an Autonomous Scientific Society under the administrative control of Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MoE & IT), Government of India in Collaboration with IQAC, B.H.B. College, Sarupeta has begun a three day's information technology related Workshop on 23rd March, 2022 at B.H.B. College, Sarupeta which will be continued to 25th March, 2022. The training camp, where students, farmers, Senior citizens and women will be trained separately, was inaugurated by the Deputy Commissioner of Bajali District, Mr. Bharat Bhusan Deva Choudhury. "Mobile Phones are used in every aspect of our life now-a - days and the lack of proper knowledge of its uses causes various troubles", he said in his inaugural speech. "Women or farmers can avail the benefits of various schemes and students can acquire knowledge by using mobile phones in the proper way. Therefore, to create awareness amongst people about proper and right uses of mobile phone are very important thing", he added. By delivering the welcome speech Dr. Birinchi Kumar Das, Principal of B.H.B. College, Sarupeta opines that it is necessary to prepare the rural students for a better future by the breaking the barrier of limited opportunities of rural areas and education must help the people of every section of the society. Dr. Saurav Mahanta, senior technical officer of National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT), gave a brief speech on the various information technology related awareness programme like proper uses of Mobile Phones, Cyber Crimes, E- Governance etc. Undertaken by of National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) with the help of Schools and Colleges to make aware the people of different sections of the society. Two other senior technical officer of NIELIT, Subrata Bora and Mridul Pachani, Principal of Dhamdhama Anchalik College, Dr. Gautam Chandra Das, Rector of

Arya Bhatta Academy, Sarupeta Kishore Kumar Choudhury have also delivered lecture in the insugural programme of training camp, where more than 400 women and 300 students participated, was anchored by Preeti Rekha Dutta, Assistant Professor of Assamese Department, B.H.B. College, Sarupeta.


Training Camp of Information Technology by NIELIT- Day 2: B.H.B. College, Sarupeta on 24th March :

On the second Day of the training camp, NIELIT Chose to train farmers and Women on "Use of ICT Technology for effective Farming and Cyber Security Awareness" respectively . The three – Day training programme is organized in Collaboration with the IQAC, B.H.B. College, Sarupeta. The Farmers and Women were divided in to two groups and trained by separate trainers. Mr. Mridul Pachani, Senior technical officer of NIELIT spoke to the women elaborately on frandulent activities that are currently at a rife due to the negligence and misinformation among the public . He mentioned the rising ATM fraud, bank fauds through phone calls where a person is duped by being manipulated in to sharing his or her bank details. He Informed the women that ATM fraud can be prevented if the ATM card is wrapped in an aluminum foil or kept in a box to cut off the network . Often the barriers in Communication restrict the will to learn ICT related applications among the villagers and elderly people. Dr. Saurav Mahanta, Senior Officer, NIELIT trained the farmers on the relevance and necessary usage of ICT tools and applications. He spoke on the use of google maps and how it can help farmers to find market Zones. He informed the farmers on the procedure required to be followed in order to register oneself in PM – Kishan-Nidhi. He mentioned that the farmers can use the help of mobile phones and app to check the weather and the temperature to propagate crops . He also provided the participants with farmers call centre number 1800-1801-551. A practical, demonstrative session was held wher a farmer called up the help line number and was given the required information and instructions.

Training Camp of Information Technology by NIELIT- Day 3: B.H.B. College, Sarupeta on 25th March :

The third day of the training programme by NIELIT at B.H.B. College concerning the usage of ICT in everyday affairs was a successful events. The three Senior technical officers of NIELIT, Gwahati trained women and elderly persond from the near by villages in the college campus. The group comprising of women was trained by Dr. Saurav Mahanta. He trained the women extensively on the use of apps like google maps for navigation and its role in providing security to women in unknown locations. He also provided the women with helpline numbers for Ambulance, Police and Fere department. Mr. Mridul Pachani and Mr. Subrata Bora were intrusted with the training of eldrly person. Mr. Pachani trained the participants of Google Meet navigation while Mr. Bora instructed the participants on e-Governance, Dhristi Scheme and how mobiles can help in farming activities and help them gain access to government funds and

chems. An interview was taken of the three personals of by NIELIT along with the Principal and IQAC Co-ordinator. They were overwhelmed by the participation of over 400 Students 300 women, 250 farmers and 180 elderly persons. They also suggested ways in which the college can accommodate vocational course like electrical repairing, soft skill courses like communicative English for BPO and solar computing lab for providing skill based courses for students in the near future. The three day training programme organized by the IQAC of B. H.B. College along with by NIELIT, Guwahati was able to fulfill the socio responsibility of training the community near the college on ICT and its tools.
