



## **MAJOR FINDINGS OF THE SURVEY IN THE VILLAGE**

### **1. Drinking water :**

During the survey it is found that 86 % of the total population used water of open well and hand tube well. Only 14% of the total population used the running water supplied by the Government.

### **2. Transport facility :**

Transport facility is found to be satisfactory to some extent. 70% of the length of total road is found to be pitch. Of course, some roads of the village are yet to be made pitch. It is near about 1 K.M. to the railway station and bus station from the village.

### **3. Employment :**

During the survey it has been found that 86% of the total population are farmers and labours (daily wage earners). Only 14% are Government service holder.

### **4. Health Care :**

For Medical emergencies, primary health care is available at a distance of 15 K.M. and the nearest Govt. Hospital is situated at Sarupeta only 2 K.M. away from the village.

### **5. Toilet Facility :**

100% toilet facility is available in the village of which 58% is Swatch Bharat toilet. 27% are private pucca toilet and other 15% are katcha toilet made of wood and bambo.

### **6. Electricity :**

Electricity is available in every household of which 58% household have availed under BPL (Government Supply).

### **7. Literacy :**

During the survey it is found that only 10% of the total population is found to be literate above the age group 60 and above. In the age group of 45 to 60 the literacy rate is 85% where as below 45 years age the literacy rate is found to be the highest i.e. 98%.

## 8. Housing :

Most of the houses of the village are katcha i.e. 60% where as 23% are semi pucca and 17 % are pucca.

1. Problem of unemployment

3. Lack of Govt. transport facility
4. Lack of irrigation facility
5. Lack of sophisticated hospital facilities

## **MAJOR FINDINGS OF THE SURVEY IN THE VILLAGE**

### **1. Drinking water :**

It has been found during the survey that 99% of the total population use hand pump for drinking water. There is only one community water tape in the village.

### **2. Transport facility :**

In the village bike, cycle, e-rickshaw and private vehicle are used as the main mode of transportation. The nearest highway is five (05) K.M away from the village and the village by a pucca road. The internal road inside the village is found to be kachha.

### **3. Employment :**

70% of the total population is employed in farming on their own land and 5% farmers is engaged in sharecropping and leased land. Skilled wage earners are found to be 35%. Only 3% of the total population are Govt. employees and 10% are engaged in trade and business.

### **4. Health Care :**

There is no primary health centre in the village. The nearest health centre is 2.5 K.M away from the village.

### **5. Toilet Facility :**

Most of the people of the village use private toilet i.e 98%. Most of them have got the benefit of Swachh Bharat Mission toilet.

### **6. Electricity :**

99% households are connected with electricity..

### **7. Literacy :**

The literacy rate in the village is found to be 60%.

## 8. Housing :

All the households have their own house of which 70% are pucca house, 10% is semi pucca and 30% is found to be kuchha.

## **MAJOR FINDINGS OF THE SURVEY IN THE VILLAGE**

### **1. Drinking water :**

Majority of the people of the village are getting clean and safe drinking water but some are yet to get the same.

### **2. Transport facility :**

In the village bike, cycle, e-rickshaw and private vehicle are used as the main mode of transportation. The nearest highway is ten (10) K.M away from the village and the village by a pucca road. The internal road inside the village is found to be kachha.

### **3. Employment :**

Near about 65% people of the village are engaged in agricultural activities. The service holders in the village is only 18% of which majority are employed in defence service. 17% are found to be unemployed of which majority is educated unemployed.

### **4. Health Care :**

There is no primary health centre in the village. The nearest health centre is 2 K.M away from the village.

All the people in the village have their own toilet facility either of pucca or kuchha.

### **6. Electricity :**

The villagers mostly use the tube well and open well for drinking water. All families have private water facility. None of the families of the village have been able to avail the Jal Jevan Mission scheme of the Govt.

### **2. Transport facility :**

The transport facility in the village is very poor. Mostly private vehicle are used as means of transport. The roads inside the village are found to be kuchha. It is near about 3 K.M. to Sarupeta Railway station and public bus stand from the village.

### **3. Employment :**

Near about 80% people of the village are engaged in agricultural activities. The service holder in the village is only 05%.

### **4. Health Care :**

There is no primary health centre in the village. The nearest health centre is 3 K.M away from the village.

### **5. Toilet Facility :**

All the families have private toilet facilities of which some are pucaa and some are kuchha. A good numbers of families have been able to have the toilet facilities under Swachh Bharat.

### **6. Electricity :**

All the households in the village are connected with electricity of which 30% have avail the BPL electricity connectivity..

### **7. Literacy :**

The literacy rate in the village is found to be 71%.

### **8. Housing :**

All the households have their own house of which 49% are pucaa house, 21% is semi pucaa and 30% is found to be kuchha.

Most of the families use tube well as source of drinking water. A small percentage of the households use drinking water supplied by the Jal Jivan Mission.

### **2. Transport facility :**

The transport facility more or less is found to be satisfactory. The roads inside the village are mostly kuchha road. Of course the connectivity road to the railway and bus station ia pucca.

### **3. Employment :**

The main source of employment in the village is farming. Nearly 60% people are engaged in agricultural activities. A good number of people work as daily wage earner in the village. The percentage of Govt. service holder is found to be very poor i.e near about 4 to 5% only.
